<b>Main Purpose:</b>	To be part of the administration team with specific responsibility for the effective running of reception
<b>Main Activities:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To provide and maintain an effective, efficient and welcoming reception area and visitors room</li> <li>• To keep a log of all visitors to the college, ensuring they all sign in, issue identity badge and safeguarding/evacuation information</li> <li>• Answer all telephone enquiries promptly and take accurate messages as necessary and pass on to the appropriate person</li> <li>• Keep a log of all incoming calls that pass through the switchboard</li> <li>• Ensure telephone lists are up to date and distribute to staff</li> <li>• To be a qualified first aider, administering first aid to pupils, staff and visitors as required and maintaining appropriate records of first aid administered</li> <li>• To liaise with parents/carers regarding pupil medical and first aid issues</li> <li>• Upkeep of first aid kits for trips etc.</li> <li>• Fire Marshal - taking the relevant reception documents to the fire assembly point to account for staff and visitors</li> <li>• Use SIMS to locate pupils as required</li> <li>• To sort, frank and take the outgoing post to the Post Office</li> <li>• Distribution of post into internal staff pigeonholes</li> <li>• Co-ordination of booking of conference rooms</li> <li>• Co-ordination of trip responses and liaising with relevant staff</li> <li>• Co-ordination of immunisation consent forms</li> <li>• Recording of attendance at extra-curricular clubs</li> <li>• Production of weekly staff bulletin</li> </ul>
<b>Support/additional duties:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To play a full part in the life of the school community and to support its distinctive mission and ethos.</li> <li>• Promote and safeguard the welfare of children and young persons you are responsible for or come into contact with.</li> <li>• Be aware of and comply with policies and procedures relating to safeguarding, health, safety and security, confidentiality and data protection, reporting all concerns to an appropriate person.</li> <li>• Be aware of, support and ensure equal opportunities for all.</li> <li>• Contribute to the overall ethos/work/aims of the school and supports its distinction mission</li> <li>• Appreciate and support the role of other professionals.</li> <li>• Participate in training and performance development as required</li> <li>• To attend first aid training as required in order to be able to provide first aid to pupils, staff and visitors as required</li> <li>• To attend other training courses as required</li> </ul>
