Clothing

- ☐ Appropriate uniform (as directed)
- ☐ Waterproof jacket
- ☐ Warm jumper or fleece
- ☐ Spare socks
- ☐ Hat (seasonal)
- ☐ Gloves (winter)

Food & Drink

- ☐ Packed lunch (unless advised otherwise)
- ☐ Healthy snacks
- ☐ Minimum 1 litre of water

Equipment

- ☐ Notebook
- ☐ Pen
- ☐ Medication (where required)
- ☐ Sun cream (summer)
- ☐ Insect repellent (if required)

Optional

- ☐ Small rucksack
- ☐ Camera
- ☐ Spare T-shirt

Bedding (if required)

Medication
